TOURNAMENT CODE OF CONDUCT

Competitors who are Members of Singapore PGA shall be penalized if they fail to observe the code of conduct as follow;

No show for tournament	S\$200.00 fine plus entry fee
Late in registration/ reporting	S\$200.00 fine
Last minute withdrawals (less than 48 hours' notice to office)	S\$200.00 fine
Failure to complete the round	S\$200.00 fine
Non-submission of scorecard	S\$200.00 fine
Failure to comply with rule of golf **	S\$200.00 fine **
Failure to comply with dress code	S\$200.00 fine

** The abovementioned rule is subject to the board of Committee's decision and cases to cases.

Players who stop play due to injures **MUST** submit a medical certificate to the organizers within five (5) working days from the last date of the event.

When the entry has been accepted by the Organizing Committee, the player must submit in writing the Organizing Committee, their reason(s) for withdrawal.

The Organizing Committee views last minutes cancellation/withdrawal very serious as may at their discretion; impose a ban on the player for future tournaments, in addition to penalties mentioned above.

*** Please note that the Official Tournament Director's decision will be deem as final in any Circumstances or dispute throughout the tournament.

Senior Cat. Professional

The Senior category must abide by the rules govern by the Singapore PGA as stated below: -

- Only allow to play in any senior category sanction event by PGA.
- Has to notify Singapore PGA in writing or fax any overseas tournament.
- Not entitle to participate in any open category tournament unless is senior event.

Teaching Professional

- Teaching Professional is invited to participate in the SPGA Circuit Event treated as taking the upgrade test to Category A (Full membership) if they pass.
- Teaching Professional will not entitle to Prize money.
- Teaching Professional may be appointed by the Executive Committee to serve in the Management Committee and or any Sub-Committee duly appointed by the Executive Committee.
- Teaching Professional shall not participate, whether as competitor or otherwise in any professional golf tournament sanctioned by the Association unless the Teaching Professional participates without the credentials of the Association, and provided always that the prior approval of the Executive Committee is obtained.
- Teaching Professional has no voting rights and he shall not be eligible for election to hold office in the Executive Committee.
- Teaching Professional shall not be eligible to propose or second any application for election to hold office in the Association and he shall also not
